

**As a repeat camper there is some special information just for you...**

Our repeat campers are very special to us. We want to make it easier for you to return to camp year after year. The more you come, the easier it is for us to help you earn your badges, and the easier it is for you to earn them. You are familiar with our procedures, you know where things are, and you know how to make the most of your camp experience. We want to continue to give you incentives to attend camp, because the more experienced campers we have to help each other along, the easier it is on all of us.

**More Choices:** Each camp offers our core four activities. Repeat campers have more choices as to which level they wish to do next in a given category (beginners are strongly encouraged work on the entry level badges). Please consult the website and the camp schedule you will be emailed for the options available to you.

Course selection is limited based on:

- The need for qualified instructors to teach/evaluate the badge activity
- The free time of said instructors if the activity is not already on the schedule
- The availability of any special equipment that might be needed (such as livestock for herding)

**Repeater discounts:** You should have received some kind of discount or incentive to attend camp again this year. The same will go for next year. It could be anywhere from \$50.00 to \$100.00 off your camp fees.

**Third year campers:** If you have been camping with us for two years already, and this is your third year, you will receive a “Happy Camper” pin during the intro session on the first day.

**Sixth year campers:** If you are one of our special campers who is coming to camp for the 6<sup>th</sup> year, you will receive a sixth year “bone” for your happy camper pin. In addition, you will be extended certain privileges regarding your camping experience. Some of our core four badges only have five levels of performance. By the time you have completed your sixth year at camp, you will have had a chance to earn all of them, in some cases. If you have not yet earned them all, that’s ok—you can continue to do so. But in the categories in which you have nowhere left to go, you are entitled to choose a replacement activity from the badge list (with the limits mentioned above).

New badges come out all the time, and you may have opportunities to earn those too. Repeaters can continue to attend camp each year for reduced fees.

**Jobs:** Don’t forget that there are a number of “helper” positions at camp that could be filled by a repeat camper. These positions often get spoken for well in advance, so put in a word EARLY if you’d like to get one of them. These jobs include instructing activities, activity director, photographer, vet tech, food prep, etc. Performing these duties will provide further discounts.
